OPEN AUSTRALIAN PAIRS NOTES AND RULES

THE DAYS WILL BE VERY BUSY.

EVERYONE'S CO-OPERATION IS IMPORTANT.

GROUP GAMES ON DAY 1 MONDAY 1st DECEMBER

- 1. GROUPS A, B AND C WILL PLAY IN THE MORNING OF DAY 1. GROUPS D, E AND F IN THE AFTERNOON. IT IS VITAL THAT WE KEEP TO THE TIMETABLE. THERE IS NO PLAN B.
- 2. First games on day 1 are at 1030 or 1400. All players will start at the same time. It will be very helpful if you check-in at 1000 or 1330.
- 3. There will be the chance for practice before the first games.
- 4. The Group games will each be of 9 ends, therefore each pair will play 27 ends of bowls. The schedule allows 1 hour per game with a short break in between.
- 5. THERE WILL BE NO TIME FOR TRIAL ENDS BETWEEN GAMES. If the rink you are next due to play on is free because the previous game has finished, by all means have a practice but you must not delay the start. A seventh rink will be set out for emergencies, practice etc. but you will be playing continuously with perhaps 5 -10 minutes between games.
- 6. DEAD ENDS in group matches **not** to be replayed. Record the score as 0-0.
- 7. To remove the possible bias of one pair in a group of four playing all their games on the same rink, for the final round rink pairs will be swapped. Check the schedule.
- 8. Please bring some scorecards of your own.
- 9. Keep scorecards and hand them in at the end of each game.
- 10. IF AN UMPIRE IS CALLED IN, HIS OR HER DECISION IS FINAL.
- 11. Group winners and the two best second placed players will go through to the quarter finals.
- 12. Tie break if two or more players are tied on points the tie break criteria will be HEAD TO HEAD (within the group only)

SHOT DIFFERENCE

MOST SHOTS SCORED

We will not know the outcome of second place qualification until the end of the day. We will be in direct contact with those concerned immediately after day one has finished. If you finished second in the morning and then go home, don't make other plans for the second day.

QUARTER-FINALS

These will be played in two groups of four on Tuesday 2nd December. Games will be 12 ends therefore each pair will play 36 ends of bowls on day 2. 1 hour 15 minutes has been allowed for each game with an interval between. The winners and runners-up will go into the semi-finals.

SEMI-FINALS AND FINAL

Semi Finals on the morning of Day 3, 18 ends. Final after a decent interval, also 18 ends. Game can be called complete if it is impossible for the losing pair to win, for example 9 shots down with two ends remaining. Super end to be played if required, toss for the mat.
